Footprint Metrics Definition

Investor Allocation

- Carbon Emissions: Measures the carbon emissions, for which an investor is responsible, per USD million invested, by their equity ownership. Emissions are apportioned based on equity ownership (% market capitalization).
- Total Carbon Emissions: Measures the total carbon emissions for which an investor is responsible by their equity ownership. Emissions are apportioned based on equity ownership (% market capitalization).
- Carbon Intensity: Measures the carbon efficiency of a portfolio, defined as the ratio of carbon emissions for which an investor is responsible to the sales for which an investor has a claim by their equity ownership. Emissions and sales are apportioned based on equity ownership (% market capitalization).
- Financed Carbon Emissions: Measures the carbon emissions, for which an investor is responsible, per USD million invested, by their total overall financing. Emissions are apportioned across all outstanding shares and bonds (% Enterprise Value including cash).
- Total Financed Carbon Emissions: Measures the carbon emissions for which an investor is responsible by their total overall financing. Emissions are apportioned across all outstanding shares and bonds (% Enterprise Value including cash).
- Financed Carbon Intensity: Measures the carbon efficiency of a portfolio, defined as the ratio of carbon emissions for which an investor is responsible to the sales for which an investor has a claim by their total overall financing. Emissions and sales are apportioned across all outstanding shares and bonds (% Enterprise Value including cash).

Weighted Average Carbon Intensity

- Corporate Constituents: Measures a portfolio's exposure to carbon-intensive companies, defined as the portfolio weighted average of companies' Carbon Intensity (emissions/sales).
- Sovereign Constituents: Measures a portfolio's exposure to carbon-intensive economies, defined as the portfolio weighted average of sovereigns' GHG Intensity (emissions/GDP).

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
